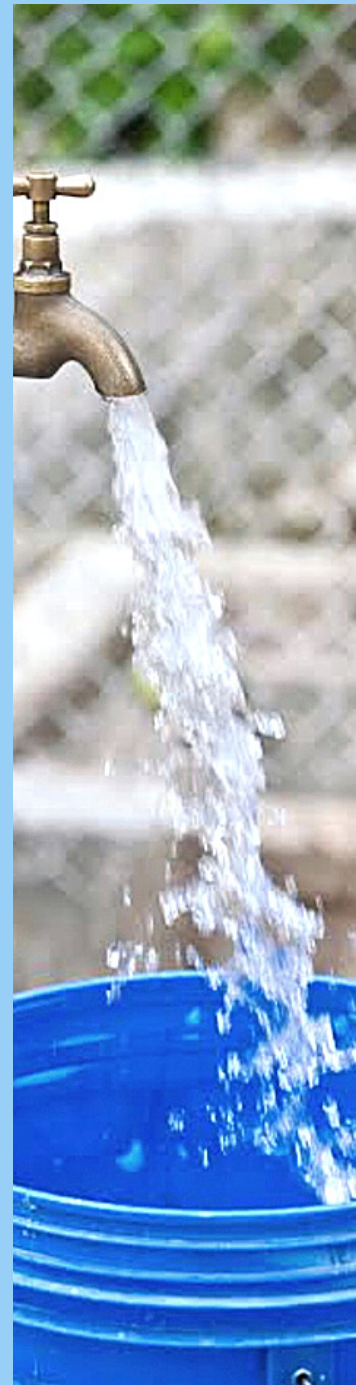

Introduction

The Haikata historical water well found in Haikata street, Mtonya ward, Mtwara-Mikindani district in Mtwara region is a tourist attraction and source of water for locals who live there. It was discovered in the 16th century and in 2017 it was renovated for the goal of provision of clean water. In collaboration with the health and clean water committee, it is decontaminated from time to time to ensure provision of clean and safe water.

Availability of clean and safe water is important in protecting civilians' health and prevention of disease outbreaks including Neglected Tropical Diseases (NTDs) such as Trachoma, a disease that causes blindness.





About the project

Clean face, hands and environment ensure control of disease outbreak in the community.

In June, 2021 the then Head of Health Cluster of Southern African Youth Forum (SAYoF-SADC), the late Maximillian Kilipamwambu met with local leaders of Mtonya ward and discussed about this project at their request after visiting the well in May 2021. Unfortunately, Maximillian passed away on 8th December 2021 before implementing the project. Therefore, we the youth from Southern African countries (SADC) who are fighting against Neglected Tropical Diseases have seen an opportunity to complete this project in order to give back to the community and honor the late Maximillian.

Vision

Improving water harvesting, availability of clean and safe water and protecting the Haikata historical water well.

Mission

Building friendly and safe infrastructure for harvesting, storing and decontaminating water without altering the nature of the water will which also serves as a tourist attraction.

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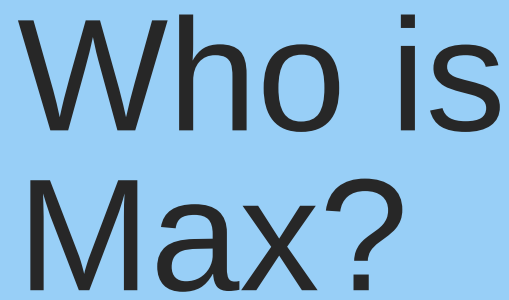
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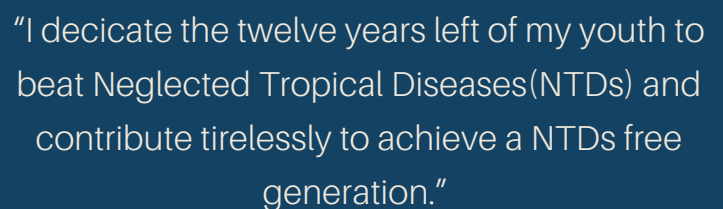

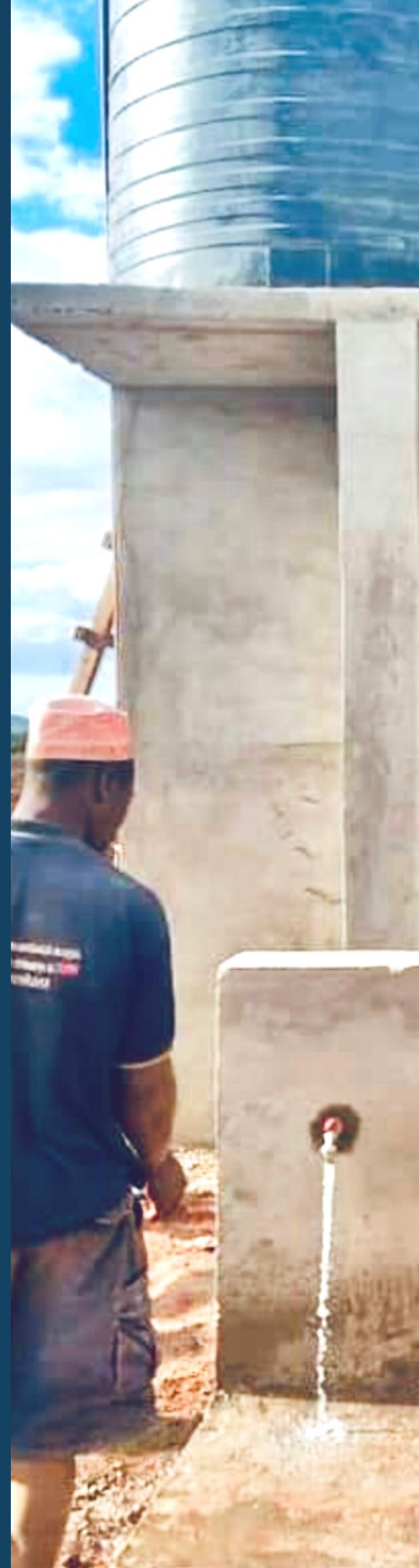


Steps Taken

3. Writing project proposal to reach out to potential stakeholders who will assist in the accomplishment of this project.

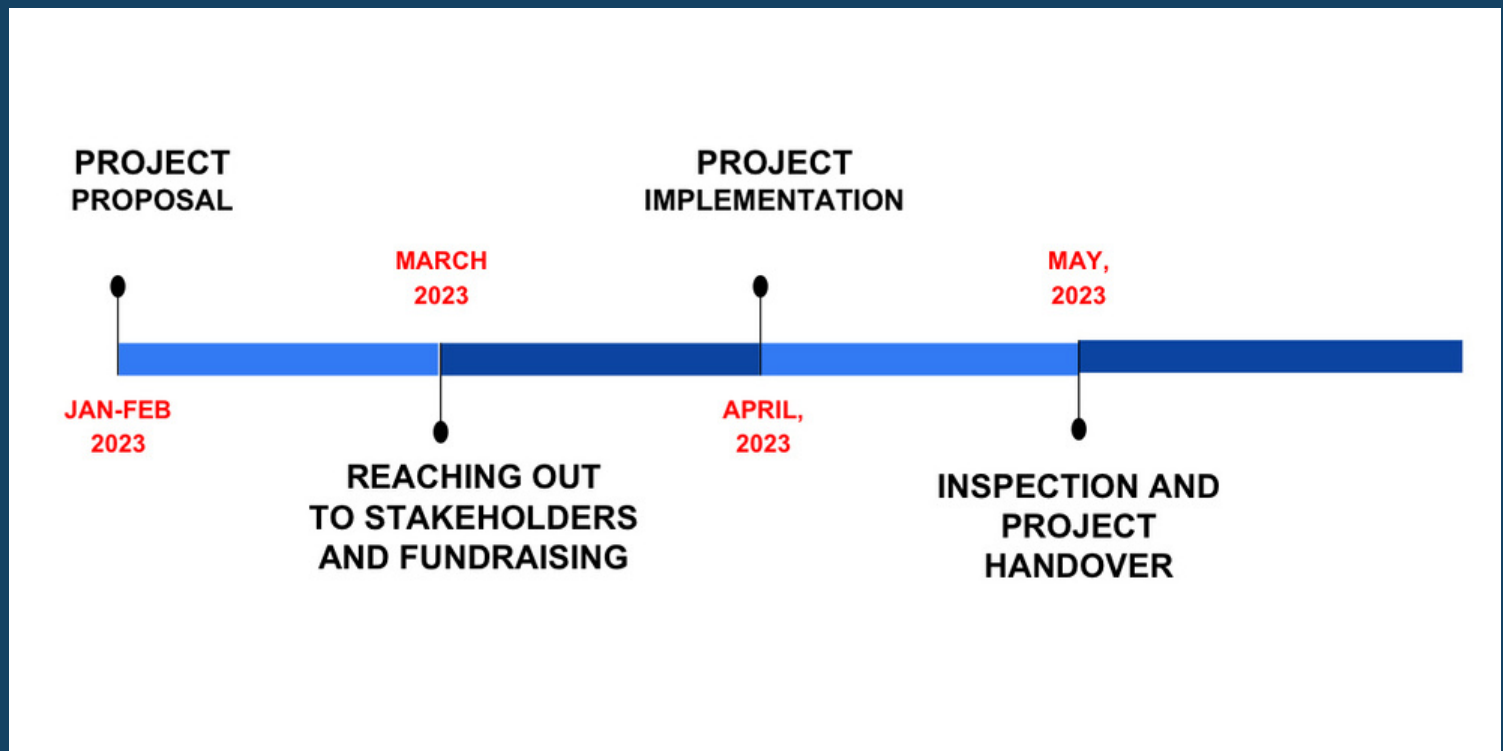
